In the Winter of 2018, Amanda transferred to Goldey-Beacom College and enrolled to pursue a major in English with a concentration in legal studies. Her mother was an alumni and spoke positively of her experiences which motivated Amanda to transfer.

Outside of school, Amanda's passions include music production, photography, and writing. In her free time she enjoys watching the Star Wars series with her little brother and spending time with her family.

She currently works in the field of Human Services as an Executive Assistant at the Delaware Department of Labor. She'd like to thank her job which has been incredibly supportive and flexible with her classes. Additionally, she would like to thank her parents, Wanda Silva and Fernando Garcia Jr., as well as her siblings and best friend Allison Hendrickson for being her support system over the years.

As a student working full time, Amanda appreciated Goldey-Beacom College's flexible class options. Undergraduate Keynote Speaker – Jeremy Benoit, Director of Athletics

Jeremy Benoit has been with the College since August of 2015, after a stint with the Ivy League Conference Office, when he was hired as the Compliance Specialist in Athletics. Now in his seventh year, Jeremy was named Director of Athletics in August, effectively making him the youngest Athletic Director in the entire NCAA at 30-years-old. He prides himself on his student-first approach and has a strong passion for community building and engagement.

Over the course of the last seven years, Jeremy has taken on many roles at GBC. He has taught courses in the Sports Management concentration, served as the Title IX Deputy Coordinator, served on several institutional committees, been advisor for the Student-Athlete Advisory Committee, and helped establish the Athletic Leadership Academy. In 2019, Jeremy also led a community service project at The Summit Retirement Community. The book of memoirs created for all of the Community's veterans ultimately yielded a donation of more than \$3,000 to the Fisher House for Families of the Fallen and a Third Place finish out of over 300 submissions for the NCAA Division II Award of Excellence. In his new role, he looks to continue to enhance the studentathlete experience through the advancement of the GBC Athletics Strategic Plan.

Jeremy is originally from New Hampshire and attended Castleton University in Vermont. He played football at CU and earned a Bachelor of Science in Sport Administration (2013), as well as a Master of Arts in Education (2015). He now lives in Wilmington with his wife, Becky, and his stepson, Connor, and has a baby girl due in early October. He would like to express his sincere gratitude to GBC leadership for their support of Athletics at the College, and especially to Dr. Chuck Hammond for being a strong advocate and leader.

Graduate/Doctoral Keynote Speaker – Lt. Governor Bethany Hall-Long

Lt. Governor Bethany Hall-Long is widely recognized as a leader who uses her skill and expertise in governance to bring people together, collaborate with her fellow legislators, build consensus, and find common-sense solutions to issues and problems facing Delaware families and communities.

Bethany has led the fight to make Delaware stronger and healthier. As the leading voice behind the creation of the Behavioral Health Consortium and as Chair, she has convened many community partners to facilitate substantive and effective change in stemming the opioid crisis and creating a behavioral health system that works for all Delawareans. Under Bethany's guidance, and through her boots-to-the-ground approach, Delaware was one of only four states in the country where drug-overdose deaths decreased in 2021.

As a trained nurse, health scientist, and University professor, Bethany understands the connection between physical and emotional wellness, which led her to launch the Lt. Governor's Challenge 2.0 in 2018. From the beginning of the COVID-19 Pandemic, Bethany directed Delaware's battle against the virus, and promoted our healthcare workers. On the frontline herself, Bethany has personally administered over four thousand COVID-19 vaccines to Delawareans statewide.

An educator herself, Bethany understands that an investment in academics is an investment in our future. Being a woman in STEM, she serves as an honorary chair of Million Women Mentors, encouraging girls to pursue careers in STEM fields. She also serves as a Hunt-Kean fellow and the Chair of the Office of Early Learning Advisory Committee.

Currently, Bethany serves as the National Chair of the Democratic Lieutenant Governor's Association. She recently served as the Chair of the National Lieutenant Governor's Association.

Bethany also served as a member of Delaware's legislature, first as a Representative and then as a Senator. She served as the Chair of the Health and Social Services committee where her efforts were aimed at improving health outcomes among Delawareans by combating addiction, focusing on a stronger mental health system, fighting cancer, and health inequities in our state. In concurrence with her work in the criminal justice system, she also serves as the President of our state's Board of Pardons, overseeing Delaware's pardons, reprieves, commutations of sentence, and executive clemency.

Bethany was sworn in for the second time as Delaware's 26th Lieutenant Governor on January 19th, 2021. She has always been and will continue to be a strong voice for all of Delaware
